SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. You must be 18 years of age or over.
2. You must be an enrolled trainee (upcoming or current course) or graduate of the Beautiful You Coaching Academy.
3. You must be someone who identifies as Black, Brown, Indigenous or a Person of Colour.
4. You must be an unpublished writer. No previously published works (including print self-published works) will be considered.
5. You must wholly own and control all rights in the submitted entry.
6. Writers who have had a full-length work published by a commercial publishing house cannot be considered.
7. You are required to demonstrate a body of work containing at least 5,000 words.
8. The work submitted needs to be a work of non-fiction in the areas of spirituality, self-help, social justice, personal growth, narrative nonfiction or health and wellbeing.
9. Submissions close on 18th September 2020 at 5:00 pm (AEST). Entries submitted after the closing date will not be considered.
10. Entries must be submitted using the online form on the kind press website.
11. Manuscripts must be submitted as PDFs or Word documents, set up as an A4 double-spaced in 12 pt Times New Roman font with page numbers on each page. Please ensure you submit your title as the file name.
12. Entries must comprise the following:
 - writers should send the first 5,000 words or full manuscript.
 - a cover sheet, with the following information:
 - Author name
 - Author's postal address
 - Project title
 - Genre(s)
 - Up to 300-word synopsis
 - a brief overview of why you wrote your manuscript
 - an up to 200-word biographical statement and (optional) extra 200-word statement sharing with us more about how you identify as a Black, Brown, Indigenous, Person of Colour and what that means to you in your life
 - an outline of the rest of the work, no more than two A4 pages long
 - you will also need to write a statement up to 750 words about how winning the publishing contract will further your writing career.
13. All entrants must intend to finish the manuscript.
14. Only one entry per person will be accepted.
15. The decision of the judges is final. the kind press will not enter into any correspondence and no individual feedback will be provided to any entrant.
16. By submitting your entry you agree to the Terms & Conditions.



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TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The Submission Guidelines form part of the Terms & Conditions.
2. You warrant that your entry: a. is your own original work; b. is not defamatory; c. does not infringe any existing copyright or licence or any other third-party rights; d. does not contain any material in breach of official secrets, confidentiality obligations or any other laws; e. does not invade any individual's rights of privacy; and f. all statements in the manuscript purporting to be facts are true.
3. You warrant that: a. you have full power to enter The Spirit Scholarship; b. you are the sole author and owner of all the copyright in your entry; and c. the material entered has not been previously licensed for exclusive use in any form in any territory.
4. The copyright in your entry shall remain your intellectual property, and your moral rights as a creator will be recognised and respected.
5. If your entry wins, you and the kind press agree to negotiate the terms of a worldwide rights publishing agreement, in good faith. During this time, you understand that your work cannot be published or offered to another publisher without the kind press' consent.
6. The winner will be announced on the kind press and Beautiful You Coaching Academy's Facebook and Instagram accounts on Friday 2nd October 2020 at 9am.
